


The State of Managed IT Services in Small Businesses

Forty-two percent of small business owners surveyed have managed IT services in place for their business.

With managed IT services, they feel more confident in their capabilities to navigate:



Those that do not have managed IT services for their small business feel less confident, especially when it comes to cyber security.



Twenty-one percent of small business owners don't know what managed IT services are, which signals a significant knowledge gap on the value of managed services.

Business Size and Cost are the Biggest Barriers

The top reasons why small business owners don't have managed IT:

Phishing Detection Could Be the Hook

Of the cyber security offerings available through managed IT services, small business owners are most interested in:

intrusion detection

phishing detection

With the top three most dreaded IT challenges for small business owners being device viruses (42%), back-up and disaster recovery (38%), and phishing



attacks (35%), it's no surprise that cyber security is the top IT need that small business owners prefer to outsource (42%).


